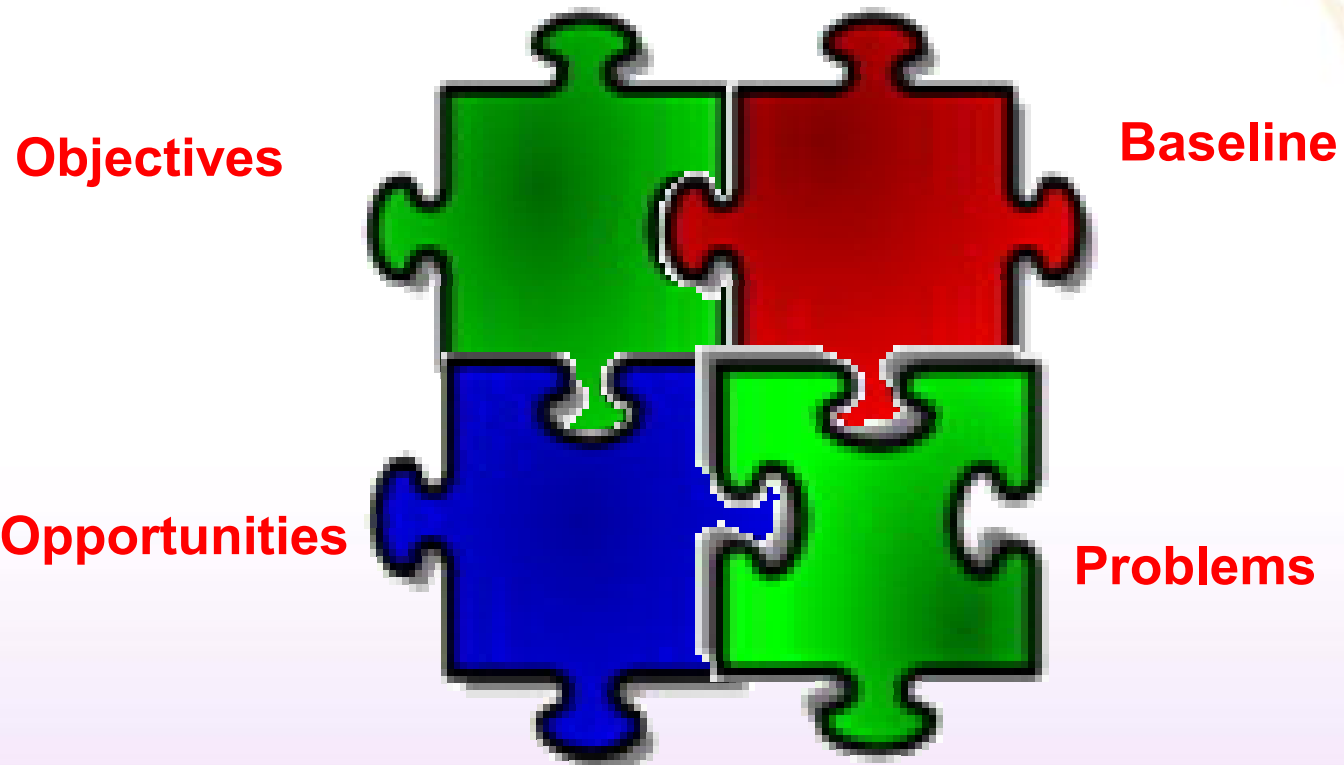
Activities for plan making authorities

- **Establish the environmental baseline**
- **Identify environmental/sustainability issues and opportunities**
- **Develop SA/SEA objectives, indicators**

Environmental building blocks

Aim of early stages is to provide the full picture

- **Seen by Consultation Bodies as their major stages of consultation input**
- **Sets the scope for the remainder of the process**
- **Needs to concentrate the assessment towards the significant impacts**
